

# PRIORITY GROUPS

for receiving H1N1 vaccine because they are at higher risk of complications:



- **People 6 months through 24 years of age**, because they are at higher risk of complications.
- **People 25 years through 64 years of age** who have certain medical conditions that put them at higher risk for influenza-related complications.
- **Pregnant women** because they are at higher risk of complications and can potentially provide protection to infants who cannot be vaccinated.
- **People who live with or care for children younger than 6 months of age**, because younger infants are at higher risk of influenza-related complications and cannot be vaccinated.
- **Healthcare and emergency medical services personnel** because their infection can spread to vulnerable patients. Absenteeism in this population can also reduce health care system capacity.
